SERVICES OFFERED (Included in school fees)

Kindermusik: Mondays - This is a specialised music and movement program focusing on child development and music stimulation programs to facilitate whole-brain development. Babies have baby music.

Robotics: At our school, we offer an exciting Robotics programme that introduces learners to the world of technology and programming. Using Cubroid Coding Blocks, students can easily learn the basics of coding and robotics in a fun, hands-on way. These blocks are wireless, making them easy to connect and use, allowing learners to build and programme their own robots while developing critical thinking, problem-solving, and creativity. Our Robotics program helps prepare students for a tech-driven future, fostering skills that will be essential in tomorrow's world.

Clamber Club: Tuesdays - This is a concentrated program to encourage gross motor development in small groups. Concepts of numbers, colours, and shapes are also taught through creative movements, and imaginative games are played. Babies have baby Clamber Club.

Occupational Therapy: Wednesdays - An occupational therapist, offers specialised stimulation classes that are age-appropriate. All aspects of being school-ready by the age of 5 are addressed in a group setting. Babies have an intense stimulation program.

Art (Art is lots of fun!): Offered daily to expand your toddler's imagination, practice fine motor skills, and ensure lots of laughter.

Bake and Make: Baking and making together with toddlers is a wonderful way to teach your child skills such as counting, measuring, weighing, and understanding time – without them even realising it.

Story time: There is at least one story time per quarter related to certain themes. All our external institutions utilise personnel with appropriate qualifications in education, music, art, and occupational therapy.

School Rules and General Information:

Religious Policy: Doxa Deo Kids Academy is a Christ Centred school that pursues Christian values and principles.

Language Policy: We are a dual-medium school and offer instruction and teaching in both Afrikaans and English..

School Hours:

Monday – Friday: 7:00 - 17:00

Please respect the closing time of 17:00.

A fine of R30 per 5 minutes will be imposed after 17:00, payable immediately to the teachers on duty.

The school will be closed on public holidays and special school vacation days designated by the Department of Education. The school will also be closed one day after the school concert and one day for teachers day in October. We will however be open during school holidays. Calendar will be communicated with parents.

The school will also be closed during December holidays.

During school vacations, a holiday program will be offered at no additional cost for Doxa Deo students. Other students who wish to join us during vacations are welcome at an extra cost.

Parents are requested to be on time in the morning; no child should be later than 8:00 at the school. It is very disruptive for the learners and teacher who then starts with class time, and the child misses important milestones.

5. Safety

- Children should be accompanied with an adult to the classroom in the mornings.
- No person other than those indicated on the child's registration form may pick up a child without parental permission.
- Kindly inform us of any trauma your child may experience so that we can handle it appropriately.
- The school reserves the right to ask parents to report the nature of any injuries or marks if a child arrives at school with any. If a parent refuses, the school will be obligated to report it to the SAP (South African Police) or the Department of Health and Welfare.

6. Meals and Refreshments

- Breakfast in the form of warm porridge is provided to the preschoolers.
- Children receive a daily healthy, balanced lunch.
- Ample filtered drinking water is available.
- Notify the school of any allergies. We are a peanut-free zone!!!
- No food or sweets may be sent to school.
- Babies and toddlers provide their own formula milk.

7. Notification to the School

Parents must inform the school if a child is absent.

8. Toys

No toys from home are allowed at the school.

9. Birthdays

A birthday is a big event, and we would love to celebrate it. Parents are very welcome to send cupcakes and/ party packs to school for a class party. We kindly request no lollipops.

10. Communication to Parents

- Communication will also be posted on the class's WhatsApp group.
- Emails will also be sent from time to time.

11. Requirements

Daily

Babies: 3 - 18 months

- 8 diapers
- Diaper rash cream
- Wet wipes
- 2 extra sets of clothes
- 5 burp cloths
- Cloth bags
- Bottles
- Formula milk
- Own soft foods – for breakfast, snack time, and lunch if they cannot eat school food yet.
- Blanket
- Cot bedding if necessary

Toddlers: 19 months - 3 years

- Extra set of clothes
- Disposable diapers
- Diaper rash cream
- Wet wipes
- Plastic bag
- Bottle/milk and/or sippy cup
- Comb/brush

Preschoolers: 3 years - 5 years

- Extra set of clothes & underwear
- Bottle of water

All personal items must be CLEARLY MARKED!

Quarterly

- 2 Packs of wet wipes
- 1 Box of tissues
- 1 Bottle of hand soap
- A separate stationary list will be provided for each class. (Annually)

12. Appointments

Parents/guardians are invited to discuss any concerns with us. If the learners progress is not satisfactory, and their behaviour is challenging to us, the teacher and principal will schedule an appointment with the parent/guardian. During the appointment, an intervention plan will be discussed, and the assistance of a third party, such as a psychologist, occupational therapist, or speech therapist, will be enlisted if necessary. All reports must be provided to the school.

13. Medication and Illnesses

- Vitamins should be administered at home, please.
- No medication should be left in a child's bag.
- Please sign for any medication with the class teacher.
- It is the parent's responsibility to remember to administer medication in the afternoons when the child is picked up.
- If your child develops a fever, you will be contacted immediately.
- A fever-reducing medicine will only be administered to your child with your written permission. You will be asked to come pick up your child.
- Any injury will be handled by the staff and communicated to you over the phone.
- You will be requested to come pick up your child if medical attention is required.
- Children who had a fever the previous night should not be sent to school until the fever is under control.
- In cases where infectious diseases are diagnosed, the child must be cared for at home until they are no longer contagious.

Transmissible Diseases | Return to School

- **German Measles (Rubella) | 7 days after the appearance of the rash**
- **Hepatitis A | 7 days after the appearance**
- **Whooping Cough | 21 days after the onset of paroxysms**
- **Lice Infestation | After complete cleaning and removal of lice, body, and clothes**
- **Measles | 7 days after the appearance of the rash**
- **Meningitis | Upon presentation of a medical certificate**
- **Mumps | 9 days after the appearance of swelling**
- **Scabies | 24 hours after proper and effective treatment**
- **Stomach Flu | Upon presentation of a medical certificate**
- **Chickenpox | 14 days after the appearance of the rash**
- **Strep Throat | Upon presentation of a medical certificate**
- **Diarrhea with fever | After the condition has completely cleared**
- **Eye Infections, including "Pink Eye" | After the infection has completely cleared**
- **Hand, Foot, and Mouth Virus | After the blisters have dried up**

14. Clothing and Shoes

Everything must be marked, including blankets.

15. Head Lice

NO child is allowed at school with head lice. Parents will be immediately contacted if it is noticed. The child may not return to school until their head is free of lice and nits.

16. Admission Conditions

Admission: Children between the ages of 3 months and 5 years will be admitted, provided that numbers allow.

Notice: Written notice for one calendar month or full month's fees is payable in the absence of such notice period if your child's enrolment is terminated.

17. Change of Contact Details

Any change of address (home or work) and/or phone number must be communicated immediately.

Registration fee (payable yearly) - R 1 520.00

Advance Payment:

- Fees are prepaid in advance for 11 months of the year before or on the last day of each month.
- If the total annual fees are paid before the end of February, a 5% discount will be granted.

One-Time Enrolment Fee:

- A one-time non-refundable enrolment fee of **R1 520 is immediately payable** during a new enrolment to secure your child's place.
- A yearly **re-registration fee of R890** is applicable (non-refundable). The enrolment and re-registration fees cover all visits and outings.

Fee Revision:

- Fees will be reviewed annually, effective every January. Details will be communicated during October of the previous year.
